

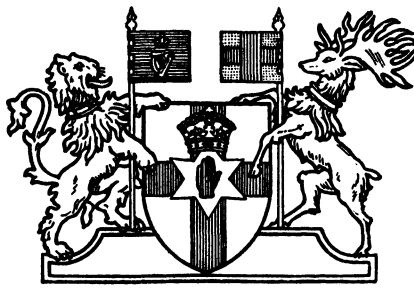

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Programme of Census Reports

1. A Preliminary Report on the 1971 Census was published in October, 1971, and contained a brief statistical commentary and provisional figures of the population, private dwellings and private households for all local authority areas (counties, county boroughs, municipal boroughs, urban and rural districts) and population figures for small towns and villages with 50 or more houses but having no defined boundaries.

2. County Reports

Reports were published for each of the Counties of Fermanagh, Tyrone, Londonderry (including Londonderry County Borough), Armagh, Down, Antrim and the County Borough of Belfast. The tables gave figures for counties, local authority areas, wards, district electoral divisions and towns and villages with 50 or more houses. The subjects covered were population and area (hectares); sex, age and marital condition; birthplace; religion; private dwellings, households, tenure and amenities; private motor cars and garaging; economically active persons and their sex and occupational status.

3. Summary Tables

Summary tables gave summaries of the information contained in the County Reports for Northern Ireland. Additionally, this report gave statistics covering the same subjects included in the County Reports for the new local authority areas which became functional on 1st October, 1973.

4. Housing and Household Composition Tables

The Housing Tables contained tabulations, not covered by the County Reports, on dwellings, households, tenure, household amenities, cars and garaging. Most tables referred to Northern Ireland but some tables included figures for local authority areas. The Household Composition Tables provided information on the composition and social and economic characteristics of households.

5. Economic Activity Tables

The Economic Activity Tables will give statistics of the occupied population based on their personal occupation and the employed population classified according to the branches of industry in which they are employed with reference to age, marital condition, employment status, socio-economic group, etc. Most tables will refer to Northern Ireland but some tables will cover local authority areas.

6. Workplace and Transport to Work Tables

These tables contain details of the resident population and the population employed in each area, the main workplace movements from one area to another and the main means of transport to work used for such movements.

7. Migration Tables

These tables gave statistics of the numbers and characteristics of people who changed their usual residence in the year or in the five years before Census day with details of their age, sex, marital condition, area of previous residence; and of the number and characteristics of migrant households.

8. Religion Tables

The Religion Tables gave by the main religious denominations, details of the people by sex, age, marital condition, occupation, industry and socio-economic group; and the numbers and characteristics of households.

9. Education Tables

These tables will give details of the age, sex, occupation and industry of those people who had obtained any academic or vocational qualification and details of the type level and subject of the qualification held.

10. Fertility Tables

The Fertility Tables will give statistics derived from information supplied for married women under 60 years of age at Census about the date of marriage and the number and spacing of children born alive to them in marriage.

WORKPLACE AND TRANSPORT TO WORK TABLES

General Explanatory Notes

In the tabulation of statistics by place of work and area of usual residence the smallest areal unit for which figures are shown is the administrative or local authority area. At this level the statistics show the total working population resident in an area, the number of these persons who work within the area and the numbers of persons who work in the area but reside in other areas. Thus, the figures show the outward flow of people who reside in an area and work elsewhere, and an inward flow of people who work in an area and reside elsewhere. People in each of the movement streams are further classified according to occupation, industry and socio-economic group.

In addition to the question on workplace, employed persons were asked to state the main means used for the longest part, by distance, of the journey to their places of work. Information was sought on the number of cars available to private households. Data of this kind is useful in the study and planning of urban transport requirements and traffic problems.

Census Population

The 1971 Census population comprises all persons irrespective of their usual address or nationality, who spent census night in the area of enumeration. Members of the Armed Forces (including those of Commonwealth and foreign countries except personnel aboard foreign naval vessels) are included. Persons travelling on census night were enumerated with the population of the district in which they arrived the next day unless they had already been enumerated elsewhere. Persons on vessels at moorings or anchorages in Northern Ireland waters or on board ships on coastwise voyages to Northern Ireland ports were counted as part of the population of the district containing the mooring, anchorage or arrival port. (The enumerated population excludes persons who, although usually resident in the area, spent census night elsewhere. People on night work were regarded as present in their homes for census purposes).

Population covered in this Report

The statistics in this report include all people aged 15 and over who were stated to be resident in, and employed at a workplace in Northern Ireland. Persons working in Northern Ireland but resident elsewhere, and persons resident in Northern Ireland but working elsewhere have been excluded from the workplace movement and means of transport figures. Members of the Armed Forces enumerated in Service establishments who were not asked the place of work and means of transport to work questions have also been excluded from these tables.

Economically Active Population

The economically active persons were those in the following categories:—

- (a) **In employment** during the week ended 24th April, 1971. This includes own-account workers, part-time workers, casual or temporary workers and persons working in a family business. Persons temporarily away from work during the week because of holidays, sickness or injury, strikes or industrial disputes and temporary laid-off are counted as in employment if their jobs are awaiting them when they are in a position to resume work, and
- (b) **Out of employment** throughout the week ended 24th April, 1971. This includes persons actively seeking work, persons prevented from seeking work by temporary sickness or injury and those who although not in employment had found a job but were to start work after census day.

The remaining persons are classified as economically inactive in one or other of the following categories:—

- (a) **Retired** means formerly occupied persons who have ceased working and are no longer seeking further employment. Housewives and persons engaged in home duties are not classified as "retired".
- (b) **Students** are persons in full-time attendance at an educational establishment irrespective of whether or not they have part-time or seasonal employment.
- (c) **Others economically inactive** are those persons never in employment and not seeking it. Included are persons of independent means, housewives and others engaged on unpaid domestic duties, the permanently sick or disabled, residents of chronic sick and psychiatric hospitals and prisoners who were serving a sentence of six months or more. Trainees in Government training centres were by convention included in this group.

Resident Population

The resident population of an area is the number of people who stated in reply to the 'usual address' question on the census forms that they were usually resident at an address in that area. Most people were enumerated at their actual residences and simply wrote 'here' in reply to the question, but people only temporarily present at an address on census night had to give their usual address in full. The persons regarded as having their usual address in the area of enumeration include:

- (i) Persons enumerated in their own homes, and those enumerated in, and having a settled residence in private lodgings, boarding houses and hotels.

- (ii) Resident domestic staff enumerated at their place of work.
- (iii) Resident staff and persons who were shown to be permanent inmates of homes for old people, homes for terminal care, homes for handicapped persons and homes for persons requiring special care.
- (iv) Persons with no fixed address and persons for whom usual addresses were not stated and which could not be assumed from the census returns.

Place of Work

Details of the address of place of work were collected from all persons with a job in the week ended 24th April, 1971. The place of work question on the census form was worded as follows:

What is the full address of the person's place of work?
If the work is carried on mainly at home, write 'At home'.

The following notes were given for the guidance of particular groups:

For people who do not work regularly or who travel during the course of their work (for example, sales representatives, seamen and certain building and transport workers):

- (a) if they report daily to a fixed address or depot give that address.
- (b) if they do not report daily to a fixed address or depot write 'No fixed place'.

for people such as building workers employed on a site for a long period give the address of the site.

It was necessary to separate the place of work question from that on name of employer and employer's business to avoid the confusion that could have arisen in some people's minds between 'employer's address' and 'place of work'. A large firm with several establishments in different areas may have one address but several places of work.

Classification of Occupations

The occupation of a person is the kind of work which he or she performs, due regard being paid to the conditions under which it is performed, and this alone determines the particular group in an occupation classification to which the person is assigned. The nature of the factory, business, or service in which the person is employed has no bearing upon the classification of his occupation, except to the extent that it enables the nature of his duties to be more clearly defined. This will perhaps be made clearer by an example. A crane driver may be employed in a shipyard, an engineering works or in building and construction, but this has no bearing upon his occupation and all crane drivers should be classified to the same occupational group. A full description of the occupation classification used in the census is given in the 'Classification of Occupations 1970' (HMSO 1970).

The full classification identifies 223 occupation groups and 27 Orders. Only the broad classification into occupation Orders is used in this report.

Socio-Economic Group

A person's socio-economic group is determined by occupation and employment status (that is, whether self-employed, manager, foreman or supervisor, or other employee). In Table 3 all employed persons are allocated to one of the following 17 groups:—

- (1) **Employers and managers in central and local government, industry, commerce, etc. — large establishments**
Persons who employ others or generally plan and supervise in non-agricultural enterprises employing 25 or more persons.
- (2) **Employers and managers in industry, commerce, etc. — small establishments**
As in group (1) but in establishments employing fewer than 25 persons.
- (3) **Professional Workers — self-employed**
Self-employed persons engaged in work normally requiring qualifications of university degree standard.
- (4) **Professional Workers — Employees**
Employees engaged in work normally requiring qualifications of university degree standard.
- (5) **Intermediate non-manual workers**
Employees engaged in non-manual occupations ancillary to the professions, not normally requiring qualifications of university degree standard; persons engaged in artistic work and not employing others thereat; self-employed nurses, medical auxiliaries, teachers and work study engineers and technicians are included; and employees (other than managers) engaged in occupations included in group (6), who formally and immediately supervise others engaged in such occupations.
- (6) **Junior non-manual workers**
Employees, not exercising general planning or supervisory powers, engaged in clerical, sales and non-manual communications and security occupations, excluding those who have additional and formal supervisory functions (these are included in group 5).

- (7) **Personal service workers**
Employees engaged in service occupations caring for food, drink, clothing and other personal needs.
- (8) **Foremen and Supervisors — Manual**
Employees (other than managers) who formally and immediately supervise others engaged in manual occupations, whether or not themselves engaged in such occupations.
- (9) **Skilled manual workers**
Employees engaged in manual occupations which require considerable and specific skills.
- (10) **Semi-skilled workers**
Employees engaged in manual occupations which require slight specific skills.
- (11) **Unskilled manual workers**
Other employees engaged in manual occupations.
- (12) **Own account workers (other than professional)**
Self-employed persons engaged in any trade, personal service or manual occupation not normally requiring training of university degree standard and having no employees other than family workers.
- (13) **Farmers — employers and managers**
Persons who own, rent or manage farms, market gardens or forests, employing people other than family workers in the work of the enterprise.
- (14) **Farmers — own account**
Persons who own or rent farms, market gardens or forests and having no employees other than family workers.
- (15) **Agricultural workers**
Employees engaged in tending crops, animals, game or forests, or operating agricultural or forestry machinery.
- (16) **Members of armed forces**
- (17) **Occupation inadequately described.**

Classification of Industries

Persons are classified by the industry in which they were employed at the time of the Census. The basis of this classification is the revised "Standard Industrial Classification" (HMSO 1968).

The Classification is based on industries and not on occupations. All persons (including administrative, technical, clerical and ancillary staffs) employed in a 'unit' of industry are included, irrespective of their occupations, in the figures of employment for the industry to which the unit is classified. The classification is also based on industries without regard to who owns or operates them. Thus the manufacturing 'units' owned or operated by the Central Government are classified in the same way as those in private hands and are not included under 'National Government Service'. Similarly, the transport services operated by local authorities are included under 'Transport' and not under 'Local Government Service'.

The Standard Industrial Classification lists 181 industrial headings which are grouped into 27 Orders. Only this broader classification into Orders is used in this report.

Means of Transport to Work

The question on means of transport to work was worded as follows:

What means of transport does the person normally use for the longest part, by distance, of the daily journey to work? If the work is carried on mainly at home write 'None'.

This question was supplemented by the following notes:

If the person uses different means of transport on different days give the means used most often. Do not use terms such as 'Public Transport' or 'Private transport' but give the actual means used, for example, 'Train', 'Public service bus', 'Employer's lorry', 'Car', 'Bicycle'.

If the person walks all or most of the way to work, write 'On foot'.

The following classification of means of transport was used:

- 0 Train
- 1 Bus (Public transport)
- 2 Bus (Private)
- 3 Car
- 4 Goods vehicle (Lorry, Van, etc.)
- 5 Motor cycle
- 6 Motor cycle combination
- 7 Pedal cycle
- 8 Foot

- 9 Other
- 10 None (Persons working at home, and seamen whose usual address is aboard ship)
- 11 Not stated (including people stating 'None' but whose usual address was different from address of workplace).

In the published tables private bus and public service bus are shown under 'Bus'. The term 'Car' includes motor cycle combinations, three-wheeled cars and electrically or mechanically propelled invalid cars.

Where more than one means of transport was recorded the one with the lowest code number on the above list was selected for coding purposes, e.g., if car and train were given, train was selected for coding purposes.

Car ownership

The head of each private household was asked the following question:—

- (a) How many cars and vans are normally available for use by you or members of your household (other than visitors)?

If none, write 'None'

Note:

Include any provided by employers if normally available for use by you or members of your household, but exclude vans used solely for the carriage of goods.

A household with a car was, therefore, a household in which there was a car or van taxed wholly or in part as a private vehicle owned and/or exclusively used by a resident member or members of that household.

Private Households

The private household is the basic unit of enumeration in the census. A private household was defined as:—

- (a) any person living alone and providing his or her own meals: or
- (b) any group of persons, whether related or not, who live together partaking of meals prepared together and benefiting from a common housekeeping.

A boarder having at least one meal (breakfast counts as a meal for this purpose) a day with the household counts as a member of the household. A lodger taking no meals with the main household counts as a separate one-person household, even if he shares kitchen and bathroom.

A person or a group of people living in a non-private establishment were treated as a separate household if they were either:—

- (a) a family who does not normally depend on the establishment for the provision of meals, or
- (b) a person or group for whom the establishment does not provide any daily meals.

A private household had to have the exclusive use of at least one room. If two people shared one room, although each may have had separate catering arrangements and did not have exclusive use of at least one other room, they were treated as one household.

Presentation Conventions

A dash (—) indicates that the entry is zero.

A blank indicates that a particular combination of line and column is impossible.

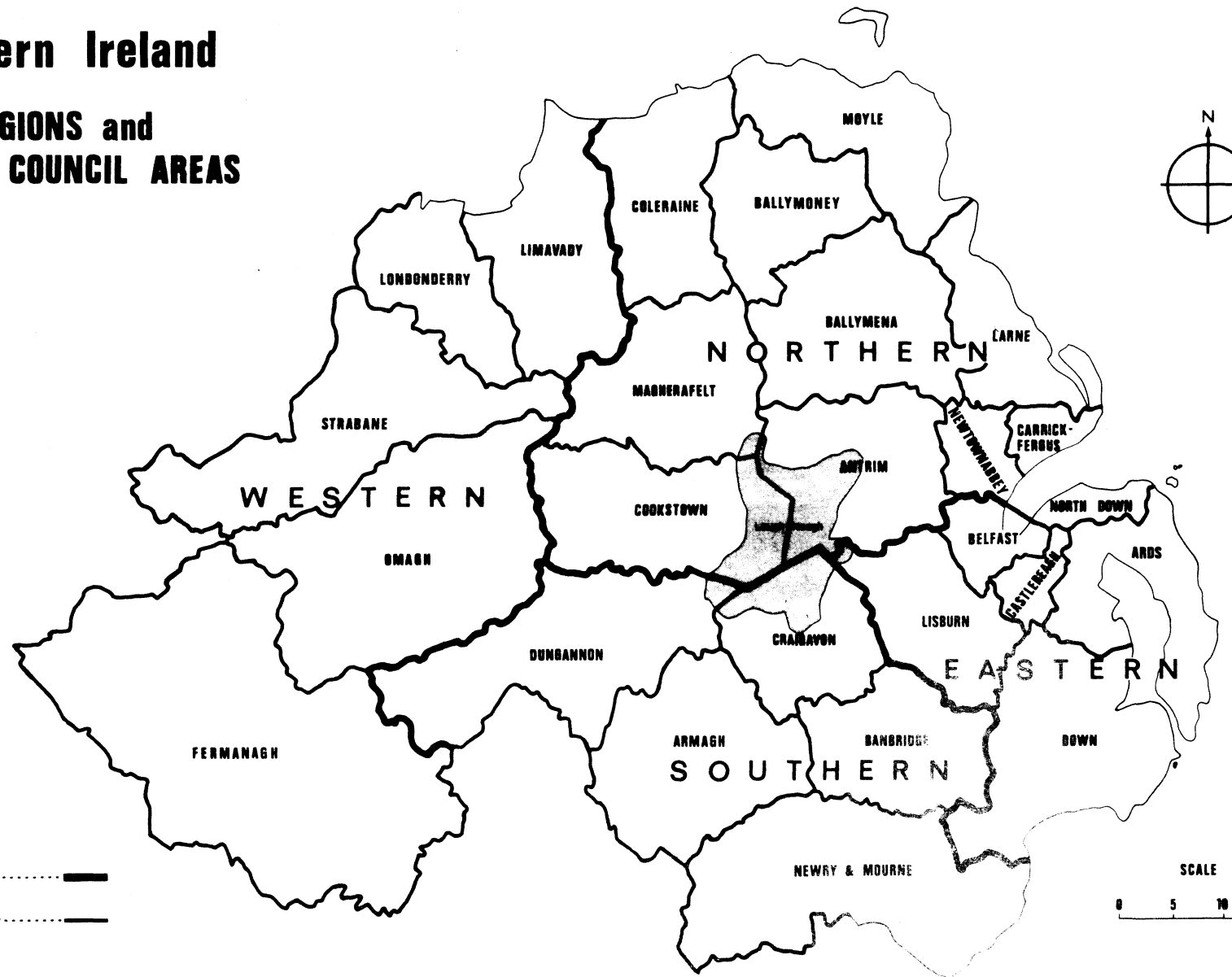
In the presentation of rates, a rate shown as 0 indicates that the actual rate is less than half of a unit but is not zero.

Areas for which statistics are presented

The local authority areas for which statistics are given comprise the administrative counties, county boroughs, municipal boroughs, urban districts and rural districts, as existing at census date. A classification of workplace movement by the new District Council Areas which became functional on 1st October 1973 is not available. These new Areas were not constituted until after the coding process of the census data had been completed.

H Form For Private Households

To the Head (or Acting Head) of the Household.

Please complete this form and have it ready for collection on Monday, 26th April. If you need help do not hesitate to ask the enumerator.

The enumerator may ask you any questions necessary to help him to complete or correct the form.

If a house, flat, apartment, etc., is occupied by two or more households, then each occupier must make a separate Return applicable to his accommodation. Boarders are not to be considered as separate occupiers but as part of the household with which they board.

The information you give on the form will be treated as **CONFIDENTIAL** and used only for compiling statistics. No information about named individuals will be passed by the Census Office to any other Government Department or any other Authority or person. If anyone in the census organisation improperly discloses information you provide, he will be liable to prosecution. Similarly you must not disclose information which anyone (for example, a visitor or boarder) gives you to enable you to complete the form.

The legal obligation to fill in the whole form rests on **YOU**, but each person who has to be included is required to give you the information you need. However, anyone who wishes can ask the enumerator or the local Census Officer for an individual form which can be returned direct to the enumerator or local Census Officer and then you need answer only questions B1 and B3 for that person. There is no penalty for refusing to state religious profession.

PLEASE TAKE NOTE

There are penalties of up to £10 for failing to comply with the requirements described above, or for giving false information.

B12 Job last week

A job means any work for payment or profit. In particular it includes:

- a. work on a person's own account
- b. part-time work if only for a few hours, such as jobbing gardening or paid domestic work
- c. casual, temporary or part-time work of any kind
- d. unpaid work in a family business including a shop or farm.

Unpaid work, other than in a family business does not count as a job. Paid work performed by full-time students in their spare time or during holidays does not count as a job.

B13 Employer's name and business

Describe the business fully and try to avoid abbreviations or initials.

General terms such as 'Manufacturer', 'Merchant', 'Agent', 'Broker', 'Dealer', 'Engineering', 'Shopkeeper', are not enough by themselves and further details should be given about the articles manufactured or dealt in.

For civil servants, local government officials and other public officials give the name of the Government department, local authority or public body and the branch in which they are employed.

For people employed solely in private domestic service, write 'Private' in answer to this question.

For members of Armed Forces see special note overleaf.

B14 Occupation

Full and precise details of occupation are required.

If a person's job is known in the trade or industry by a special name use that name.

Terms such as 'Scientist', 'Technician', 'Engineer', 'Machinist', 'Fitter', 'Foreman', 'Checker', should not be used by themselves; greater detail is required, for example:

Woodwork machinist, Civil engineer, Toolroom foreman, etc.

For civil servants, local government officials and other public officials give their rank or grade.

B15 Self-employed

'Self-employed, employing others' means having one or more employees other than 'Family workers'. A 'Family worker' is one who lives in the same household as the employer and is related to him.

B16 Apprentices, etc.

Answer this question only for a person who is undergoing training for a period fixed in advance and leading to recognition as a skilled worker or technician or to a recognised technical, commercial or professional qualification or managerial post.

Do not answer this question for a young person undergoing training who has not yet entered into formal apprenticeship.
