

CONTINUOUS HOUSEHOLD SURVEY RESULT TABLES REVISION NOTICE

10/12/2021

Following a review of data previously released on 21 October 2021, there have been some changes made to the Continuous Household Survey tables that are available on the NISRA website.

We have added notes for users that explains the change in survey methodology in 2020/21 and advises users to take caution in making direct comparisons with data from previous years. All tables have had this note added.

Furthermore, previously available disaggregated results for car ownership, internet and broadband access rates have been removed due to the small number of responses to these questions and the high level of uncertainty of these survey estimates.

These changes were identified and corrected as soon as possible on the 10th December 2021.
