## Translate pages in Google Chrome

You can use Chrome to translate a page into other languages.

## On a computer

- 1. Go to a page you want to translate.
- 2. On the right of the address bar, select Translate 🔄.
  - You can right-click anywhere on the page and select **Translate to** [Language].
- 3. Select your preferred language.
  - If Translate doesn't work, refresh the page.

## On Android device

- 1. Go to a page you want to translate.
- 2. In the notification at the top of the screen, tap the language that you want to translate the page to.
  - To change the default language:
  - a. Tap Settings Amore languages.
  - b. Select the language.

To always translate pages in this language, tap Settings Always translate pages in [language].

## On iPhone or iPad

- 1. Go to a page you want to translate.
- 2. At the top of the screen, select the language you want to translate to.
  - To change the default language, tap Settings More languages and select the language.
- 3. Chrome will translate the page this one time.

To always translate pages in this language, tap Settings Always translate pages in [language].

If, after following the appropriate steps for your device, you still can't tap **Translate**, the language might not be available for translation.
