






Follow2: In which of the following way(s) have you not followed the regulations or guidelines? asked if Follow1 = Option 2 to 7. Multiple responses allowed.













COV_C9: How worried or unworried are you about the effect that Coronavirus (COVID-19) is having on your life right now?... by month of interview








Drink1: Since the outbreak of the Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic, would you say that on the whole you have been drinking more alcohol, about the same or less?


















COV_AandE: At this time, how comfortable or uncomfortable would you be about attending Accident and Emergency (A&E) if you had an urgent health concern?








