## Annual Inquiry on Imports of Coal and Other Solid Fuels: Notes on Completion

- This statistical inquiry covers all types of solid fuels including coal, anthracite, lignite, coke and manufactured smokeless fuels.
- All solid fuels imported from GB or from another port in NI should be classed as cross-channel.
- Imports from outside the UK, including solid fuel imported from ports in the Republic of Ireland, should be classed as **foreign**.
- Fuels should be classified according to the use for which they were imported; either **domestic or industrial** or **for the generation of electricity**.
