


Annual External Overnight Trips




¹The faint grey line shows the trend had the figures for residents of the Republic of Ireland not been included; users can see that when the overnight trips from the Republic of Ireland are removed the volume of estimated external overnight trips to NI drops; however, the general upward trend remains the same. This is the longest timescale available as data for NI tourism begins in 1959.



Expenditure during Overnight Trips










Overnight Trips, 2019







Methodology – Passenger SurveysCarried out at all air and sea ports across Ireland

NISRA Passenger SurveyRandom sample of shifts/people

CSO Passenger SurveyRandom sample of shifts/gates/people

- Everyone asked about Country of Residence
- If Ireland/NI we ask no more questions
- Did you spend any nights in NI?
- How many nights?
- How much did you spend?





Methodology – Household Surveys

NISRA Continuous Household Survey Random sample of households Survey includes numerous topics

CSO Household Travel SurveyRandom sample of households

Everyone asked about Overnight trips taken in previous 4 weeks.











Figure 5: Estimated overnight trips, nights and spend by Reason for Visit and LGD









Overnight Trips (thousands)










Overnight Trips by Reason for Visit



Overnight Trips by Origin of Visitor





Figure 4: Estimated Occupancy Rates of Hotel rooms, Small Service accommodation rooms and Self Catering establishments, 2013-2023






Economic Statistics

- 5,845 VAT and/PAYE or Businesses Operating in NI, 2023
 - 23% in Belfast City Council 77% outside
 - 7% of all businesses operating in NI
- Average weekly earnings, 2023 £323.5 (compared to £528.9 NI average)
- 70,384 Tourism jobs in NI, 2022
 - 30% in Belfast, 70% outside
 - 9% of all jobs in NI

Tourism in NI is in a healthy position

An estimated 5.4 million overnight trips were spent in NI during 2023 These overnight trips accounted for an estimated £1.2 billion 51% of these overnight trips were for Holiday purposes 69% of these overnight trips were taken outside Belfast City Council Hotel occupancy in NI in 2023 was estimated to be the same as 2013
