## Text alternative for Census 2021 housing infographic for Causeway Coast and Glens Local Government District

The infographic presents key housing statistics for Causeway Coast and Glens Local Government District on census day in 2021.

### Overall

There were 57,600 households with usual residents in Causeway Coast and Glens Local Government District on census day 2021.

### Accommodation type

For Census 2021 households with usual residents:

- 48% of all households were in detached properties
- 30% of all households were in semi-detached properties
- 15% of all households were in terraced (including end-terrace) properties
- 7% of all households were in flat, maisonette or apartment properties

### Central heating

For Census 2021 households with usual residents:

- 63% of households had oil only central heating
- 11% of households had mains gas only central heating
- 26% of households had Other type(s) of central heating [note 1]

Note 1: 'Other' contains combinations of two or more types of central heating, some of which include oil and mains gas.

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## Tenure

For Census 2021 households with usual residents:

- 66% of households owned their accommodation (includes shared ownership)
- 13% of households were in the social rented sector
- 18% of households rented their accommodation privately
- 3% of households lived rent free

## Car or van availability

For Census 2021 households with usual residents:

- 16% of households had no cars or vans available
- 40% of households had one car or van available
- 30% of households had two cars or vans available
- 14% of households had three or more cars or vans available

There were 85,400 cars or vans available for use in Causeway Coast and Glens Local Government District.

There was an average of 1.5 cars or vans available per household.
