The infographic presents health characteristics of Newry, Mourne and Down Local Government District's population on census day in 2021.

General health

For the Census 2021 usually resident population:

- 80% described their general health as 'Very good' or 'Good'
- 13% described their general health as 'Fair'
- 7% described their general health as 'Bad' or 'Very bad'

Good or very good – by age:

- 93% of those aged 0 to 39 years described their general health as 'Very good' or 'Good'
- 75% of those aged 40 to 64 years described their general health as 'Very good' or 'Good'
- 52% of those aged 65 years and over described their general health as 'Very good' or 'Good'

Disability

For the Census 2021 usually resident population:

- 11% described their day-to-day activities as 'limited a lot'
- 12% described their day-to-day activities as 'limited a little'
- 77% described their day-to-day activities as 'not limited'

41,700 (23%) people have their day-to-day activities limited by a health problem or disability.

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Unpaid care

21,400 (13%) people aged 5 years and over provide unpaid care.

For the Census 2021 usually resident population aged 5 years and over:

- 1% of those aged 5 to 14 years provide unpaid care
- 10% of those aged 15 to 39 years provide unpaid care
- 20% of those aged 40 to 64 years provide unpaid care
- 12% of those aged 65 years and over provide unpaid care
